There is a \$7 donation in order to receive the food and it must be paid on the dates above. Distribution will be on Thursday, September 13, 2018, at approximately 11:15 a.m. Residents who donate the \$7 must be in the community room by 11:45 A.M. on Thursday, September 13, 2018, to pick up the PAF order or the items will be forfeited.
