Window Air Conditioners – Must be Removed by October 31st

In accordance with your lease, all window air conditioners were to be removed from all windows by October 31st. Any tenant that does not comply will be tagged this week. If Maintenance Personnel is dispatched to remove any air conditioners from your unit, a charge of \$20.00 *per air conditioner* will be posted to your account. Please remember that in addition to removing the unit, all screens must be in good repair and re-installed. Please contact the Maintenance Department during normal business hours if you require assistance in re-installing any screen. If no repairs are needed, there is no charge for this service.

Fall Clean Up Time

As winter approaches and the leaves begin to fall, it is the time to clean your yard and properly store all toys and lawn furniture. Please rake leaves and remove trash from your respective areas and dispose of properly. If you have any bushes, clean under and around them. If you are a pet owner, you are responsible for removing all pet waste.



All yards should be given a final mowing for the season, as well as trimming all fence lines and around storage bins. Any bushes, plants, or flowers should be trimmed away from all fences or buildings.

In addition to keeping your lawn areas in good condition, please do not throw food or cooking grease in your yard. Not only does it kill the grass, but it will also attract unwanted rodents. All storm and entry doors should be scrubbed and wiped clean, as well as window ledges.

Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) Information for 2019

Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits for more than 67 million Americans will increase 2.8 percent in 2019.

The 2.8 percent cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) will begin with benefits payable to more than 62 million Social Security beneficiaries in January 2019. Increased payments to more than 8 million SSI beneficiaries will begin on December 31, 2018. (Note: some people receive both Social Security and SSI benefits.)




MARYLAND EXCELS

The maryandexcels.org website and mobile app help families identify child care and early education programs that have attained one of five quality levels. By choosing a Maryland EXCELS participating program, families know that the program is committed to quality and continuous improvement by meeting standards that exceed the states licensing requirements.

You may also qualify for help with the cost of child care. The income limits have changed. See the chart below.

When is Medicare Open Enrollment?

The annual Medicare Open Enrollment period has started for 2019 coverage. Open enrollment will run from October 15, 2018, to December 7, 2018.

During the annual enrollment period (AEP) you can make changes to various aspects of your coverage.

- You can switch from <u>Original Medicare</u> to Medicare Advantage, or vice versa.
- You can also switch from one <u>Medicare</u>
 <u>Advantage</u> plan to another, or from one
 <u>Medicare Part D</u> (prescription drug) plan to
 another.
- And if you didn't enroll in a Medicare Part D plan when you were first eligible, you can do so during the general open enrollment, although a late enrollment penalty may apply.

If you want to enroll in a Medicare Advantage plan, you must meet some basic criteria.

- You must be enrolled in Medicare Part A and
 B
- You must live in the plan's service area.

You cannot have <u>End-Stage Renal Disease</u> (some exceptions apply).
